Municipal Nutrition Program Evaluation

The Provincial Nutrition Committee headed by Ms. Jean R. Apolinares, E.Ed, and member of the Provincial Nutrition Committee has conducted a yearly Monitoring and Evaluation of Local Program and Project Implemented (MELLPI) related to Nutrition Program in the Municipality of Braulio E. Dujali on March 10 and 11, 2012. The evaluation aims to measure the degree of implementation for the impact of nutrition program, namely: Home and Community Food Production, Food and Livelihood Assistance, Micro Nutrient and Food fortification for Maternal and Child Health and its Enabling mechanism down to the grassroots level or the target population group. The evaluators used the MELLPI score card as the official criterion provided by the National Nutrition Council. After the said evaluation, the team visited barangays New Casay and Magupising, all of Braulio E. Dujali, Davao del Norte.

After evaluating all cities/ municipalities and barangay , an exit conference will be called to know the result of the evaluation.

The Bureau of Local Government Finance (BLGF) Central Office Manila under the Department of Finance appointed Mr. Rannie D. Lozada as Municipal Treasurer of the Municipality of Braulio E. Dujali, Davao del Norte effective November 14, 2011. The BLGF-DOF is the sole government agency responsible for the appointments of Treasurers in all Government Offices.

The ceremonial oath taking happened on January 16, 2012 in the Office of the Municipal Mayor and was officiated by Mayor Lolita A. Moral. The occasion was witnessed by other department and section heads of the LGU.



Mr. Lozada, is a bonafide resident of Barangay Dujali. A graduate of Bachelor of Science in Commerce Major in Accounting at Southern Baptist College in March 1991. He finished his elementary and secondary levels at the then Dujali Elementary School, now Dujali Central Elementary School and Lika Barangay High School, respectively.

On April 1999, he got employed in this local government unit as Casual Clerk. His consistent performance rating as satisfactory public service was a strong merit and fitness qualification that made him be included in the roster of regular plantilla employees on July of same year. He was appointed Revenue Collection Clerk I (RCC1) in the Municipal Treasury Office (MTO) under the supervision of the then Office In-charge, Mr. Eduardo A. Alilin.

After ten months or in May 2000, as RCC I he was promoted to the position of Disbursing Officer I. Luckily in the month of December 2002, he was again promoted as Local Treasury Operations Officer I (LTOO I) under the supervision of the late Mr. Pablo A. Mondonedo, Municipal Treasurer.

During his stint as LTOO I, he was designated as Officer In-Charge of the office for several times in the absence of the head of said office.

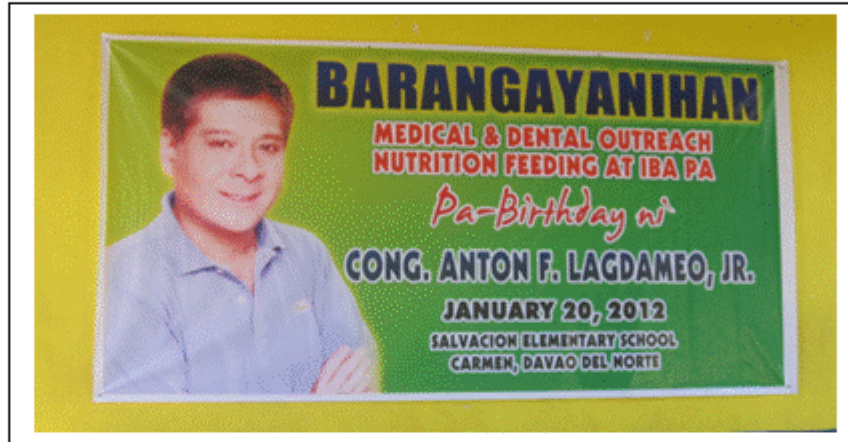

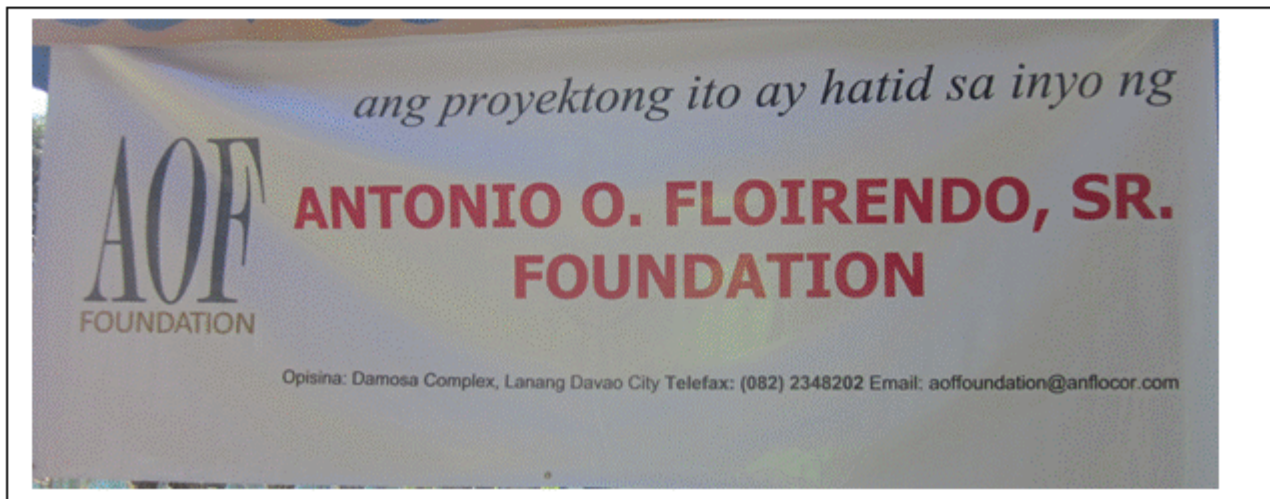
Cong Lagdameo celebrates birthday

Braulio E. Dujali wins prestigious national awards in rice production

Braulio E. Dujali, Davao del Norte, "This is the product of our collective efforts geared towards sustainable agricultural development and rice sufficiency program" said Mayor Lolita A. Moral upon receiving the awards of Agri- Pinoy Rice Achievers' Awards (APRAA) given by the Department of Agriculture.

Agri- Pinoy Rice Achievers' Awards, is a reward system for top performing rice producing **Local Government Units (LGUs)**. There are four (4) categories being competed, to wit; Municipal/City LGU, Provincial Government, Irrigators' Association (IA) and Agricultural Extension Workers (AEWs).

The program thrusts of the Local Government Unit (LGU) through the Agriculturist's Office for the past years were geared towards **Sustainable Agricultural Development** with focus on increasing rice production per unit area and improvement/ rehabilitation of farm facilities and systems for areas under rice cultivation in order to attain Rice Sufficiency and Food Security.

The Municipal Agriculturist, Nelson C. Baer took the challenge to compete in three categories, namely; MLGU, Dujali Isidro Talisay Casay Irrigators' Association (DITCIA)- 1 for Irrigators Association (IA) and Lorna Aragon- Escobar for Agricultural Extension Worker (AEW).

The LGU-Braulio E. Dujali wins the prestigious award on the basis of its exemplary performance that increase rice production through the following;

Programs and Interventions:

- Organically Grown Rice Production
- PalayCheck System Implementation
- Subsidy on Certified Rice Seeds
- Application of BioN

- Vermi Culture and Vermi Cast Production
- Village Type Trichogramma Laboratory
- Establishment of Demo Farms to showcase the latest agricultural technologies and best practices
- Establishment of Agri-Eco Park and Production Center

Strategies:

- Empowerment of Irrigators' Associations and Farmer Groups
- Pooling of Resources with other Government Agencies and Civil Societies
- Implementation of Pre/ Post Harvest Facilities and Infrastructure and Equipment
- Farmers' Empowerment through information dissemination with the services of FITS/ OPAPA the use of ICT WebCon were available, Techno Fora, Techno Clinic and Information Caravan were conducted

Results and Impact:

- Increase of Rice Production per unit area at an average of 11% per annum
- Rice Production Surplus of 6,511,855.74 kgs. per annum
- Rice Sufficiency is sustained
- Increase of Tax Collection
- Empowered Irrigators' Associations that resulted to:
 - Efficient delivery of water services
 - High Collection Efficiency Rate of irrigation service fees
 - Increased sense of ownership/ stakeholdership in the system
 - Members became law abiding

On the other hand, DITCIA- 1 wins by virtue of its exemplary performance based on **100% Collection Efficiency of Water Service Fees, Good Organizational Management, Sustainable and Efficient Water Facilities and Effective Water Delivery System** to name a few. It could be remembered that DITCIA-1 became an Outstanding Irrigators' Association throughout the country in (2005, 2006 and 2007 Grand Slam) 2008 Hall of Fame Awardee and recipient of international awards.

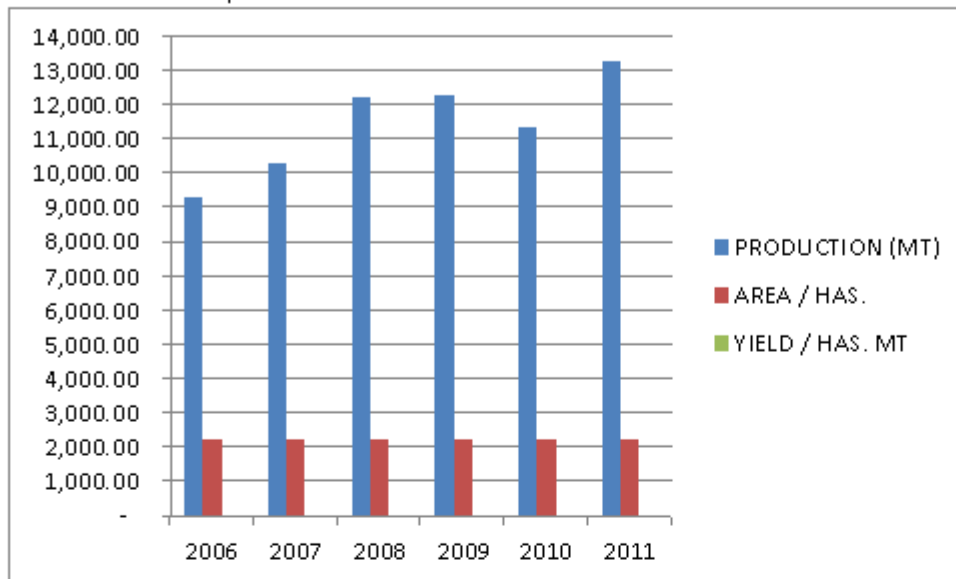

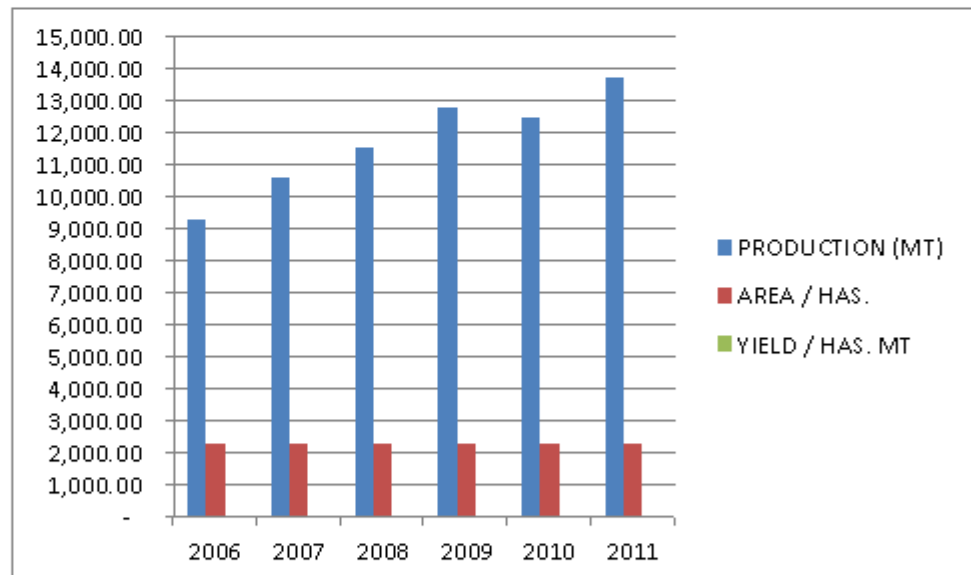
