RESOLUTION NO. 2011-69

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE CHARITY SWEEPSTAKES OFFICE (PCSO) THRU ITS CHAIRMAN, TO GIVE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BRAULIO E. DUJALI, DAVAO DEL NORTE ,TO BE USED FOR THE REHABILITATION OF DAMAGED PRIMARY LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROJECTS AND STRUCTURES.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Braulio E. Dujali is one of flood prone areas of Davao del Norte. It being located below sea level and a municipality traversed if not surrounded by big rivers and creeks and canals, easily become flooded. Records will show that flood occurs every year, not only once but twice and damage to crops, properties and government projects always reached to millions of pesos;

WHEREAS, the fear of another flooding is still there as rain comes every afternoon. The recent flood made rivers, creeks, streams and canals heavily silted that when become full, large volume of water will spill over nearby areas placing almost all parts of the municipality underwater for many days;

WHEREAS, the municipality is planning to conduct clearing activities in heavily silted areas, repair damaged protection dikes, widen canals and rehabilitate roads that had gone impassable due to bad weather, but then, it cannot get the work started much less to get the work done since the budget all these activities would entail is certainly very huge;

WHEREAS, this local government unit is indeed financially hard up, and it would be even more because the recent calamity had incapacitated taxpayers to pay their taxes from which this local government unit gets revenues to fund various programs and projects;
