RESOLUTION NO. 2013-01

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NATIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (NDRRMC) TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BRAULIO E. DUJALI, DAVAO DEL NORTE IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY MILLION PESOS (P 60,000,000.00) TO BE USED IN THE REHABILITATION OF VARIOUS STRUCTURES DEVASTATED BY TYPHOON PABLO.

WHEREAS, super typhoon Pablo that turned many parts of southern Mindanao into graveyards, had left horrifying memories for those who survived the tragedy. What made the aftermath more miserable is that banana plantations, rice fields, thousands of coconut trees and various private and government structures were blown away by fierce winds or washed off by raging flood waters, eventually transforming some once economically vibrant localities and their people totally destitute and incapacitated;

WHEREAS, the effects of typhoon Pablo's debilitating fury are indeed evident in this municipality. Though no record will show of a single casualty among the residents, the municipality also got its share of tremendous damage in farms, livestock, structures and other vital facilities thereby affecting the already pathetic living conditions of poor families;

WHEREAS, this municipality fall under the 4th income classification and is an IRA dependent locality. Its meager sources cannot in any suffice funding requirement for repairs and or rehabilitation of worn out structures, thus the need for assistance from other national institutions including the NDRRMC, as this is the only way it could help bring affected people back to their normal life again;

WHEREFORE, on unanimous accord, this body hereby

RESOLVED TO REQUEST AS THIS BODY HEREBY REQUESTS THE NATIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (NDRRMC) TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BRAULIO E. DUJALI, DAVAO DEL NORTE IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY MILLION PESOS (P 60,000,000.00) TO BE USED IN THE REHABILITATION OF VARIOUS STRUCTURES DEVASTATED BY TYPHOON PABLO.

RESOLVED FUTHER, that this body hereby expresses an assurance that this Local Government Unit will use the amount requested or any amount it will get as assistance from NDRRMC for the projects mentioned in the foregoing.
