MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO.2011-135

Sponsors: Hon. DONNA MAE L. BALDONADO

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL BANKING AND FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS OPERATING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BRAULIO E. DUJALI TO INSTALL ALARM SYSTEM IN THEIR PREMISES.

WHEREAS, Section 458 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall approve ordinances, which shall ensure efficient and effective delivery of basic services and facilities, and shall:

"(1) (ii) Maintain peace and order by enacting measure to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorders, x xxx, violence x xxx, and impose penalties for the violations of said ordinances";

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Braulio E. Dujali actively pursues programs to make Braulio E. Dujali a safe and habitable metropolis for its people and a secured area conducive to investments;

WHEREAS, banks, pawnshops, and other financial institutions are imminent targets of criminal elements which will result in destruction of lives and properties and economic instability;

WHEREAS, to deter occurrence of robbery or hold up on banking and other financial institutions, alarm system must be installed in their premises;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Braulio E. Dujali, in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. All banking and financial institutions in the Municipality of Braulio E. Dujali are hereby required to install alarm system in their respective premises.

SECTION 2.For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are hereby defined as follows:

- a) **BANKING INSTITUTION** shall refer to all banks operations within the Municipality of Braulio E. Dujali, serving as cash depositories and/or engaged in financial activities of receiving collecting and/or issuance of payments in the form of cash or other negotiable instruments.
- b) **OTHER FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS** shall refer or include pawnshop, moneylending institutions, financial cooperatives, money exchange centers, collection agencies, and the likes that store large amount of money used for their financial activities, such as granting loans, receiving or collecting payments, foreign currency exchanges, among others.

SECTION 3.The alarm system, whether in a form of a bell, a siren, or any gadget producing a loud sound and controlled by a switch shall be installed outside the premises of the building. Management shall likewise be made for the alarm system to be directly connected to the Braulio E. Dujali Police Station through appropriate circuitry.

SECTION 4. All concerned banking and financial institutions are hereby given One (1) year after approval of this ordinance to install the required alarm system.

SECTION 5.Penalty Clause. Any banking or financial institution without an alarm system after One (1) year grace period shall be imposed by a fine of Five hundred pesos (Php500.00). In case of failure to pay the fine, the suspension of the business permit and license to operate and temporary closure of the business operations shall be meted. The suspension and temporary closure shall be lifted only, if and when, the institution has complied with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. Implementing Authority. The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) and the Municipal Police Office of Braulio E. Dujali are hereby tasked to implement this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. Separability Clause. If for any reason or reasons that any part of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the provision or provisions which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 8.Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
