The Municipality of Braulio E. Dujali was a recipient of “*Skills Registry System (SRS) Project*” from the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE). It was a project initiated by DOLE since 2009, aimed at establishing and maintaining continuous SRS nationwide at the enhanced Phil-JobNet site. The SRS core target was to institute “*live*” registration of skills in every Public Employment Service Office (PESO) of the LGU and to facilitate for referral and placement of jobseekers or the registrants by giving them the lists of establishments with available job vacancies. Around 1,516 LGUs and 39,536 barangays received the said

project nationwide.

The SRS Project was launched at the Municipality of Braulio E. Dujali on July 31, 2013 held at Dapog sa Dujali, this municipality. During which, the signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the LGU represented by Hon. Lolita A. Moral, Municipal Mayor and the DOLE represented by its Regional Director, Atty. Joffrey M. Suyao, together with the Provincial Director of DOLE, Davao del Norte-Field Office, Ms. Milagros V. Gutierrez was took place.

A Computer Set was also awarded to this municipality as component facility of the project. The Barangay Captains of the five (5) Barangays of this town took their Pledge of Commitment to support the SRS Project.

Mr. Abel T. Pagatpat, Public Employment Service Office (PESO) Manager together with his Staff was tasked to handle the implementation of the said project.
