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**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2020-218**

MANDATING THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF SOCIAL OR PHYSICAL DISTANCING BY ALL PERSONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BRAULIO E. DUJALI, DAVAO DEL NORTE DURING THE PERIOD OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, Social Distancing is a public health practice that aims to prevent sick people from coming in close contact with healthy people in order to reduce opportunities for disease transmission. It can include large-scale measures like cancelling group events or closing public spaces, as well as individual decisions such as avoiding crowds;

WHEREAS, with COVID-19, the goal of social distancing is to slow down the outbreak in order to reduce the chance of infection among high-risk population and to reduce the burden on health care system and workers;

WHEREAS, Social distancing helps prevent a sharp peak of infection (“flattens the epidemic curve”) to help healthcare services deal with the demand, and extends time for healthcare services to be increased and improved;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Braulio E. Dujali manifests its desire to strictly implement social distancing and other quarantine measures with the end-in-view of preventing and/or containing the transmission of coronavirus in the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan, in session duly assembled, THAT:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS - Social or Physical Distancing – is a set of non-pharmaceutical interventions or measures taken to prevent the spread of a contagious disease by maintaining a physical distance between people and reducing the number of times people come into close contact with each other;

SECTION 2. SOCIAL DISTANCING IN THE FOLLOWING PLACES – Social distancing of at least one (1) meter (3 feet) radius from one person to another shall be strictly observed in the following places:

- a. Inside and outside of the business establishments, markets, pharmacies, banks, remittance centers, medical and quarantine facilities, private and government offices and other institutions authorized or allowed to operate.
- b. Entry/exit points, checkpoint, roads or alleys in the barangay, subdivision or villages.

SECTION 3. PERSONS RESPONSIBLE – The owner, president, general manager, or such other officer-in-charge thereof shall designate adequate security of frontline personnel to ensure the proper observance of social distancing of people within their premises.

SECTION 4. DESIGNATION OF FLOOR OR PAVEMENT MARKINGS – All business establishments, markets, pharmacies, banks, remittance centers, medical and quarantine facilities, public and private offices and other institutions located in the Municipality should designate floor or pavement markings within their premises of at least one (1) meter (3 feet) distance from one person to another to maintain the required social or physical distancing.

SECTION 5. PENALTY – Any person found in violation of social or physical distancing measures shall be penalized as follows:

- a. First (1<sup>st</sup>) Offense – Reprimand
- b. Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Offense - The offender shall be fined in the amount of Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00).
- c. Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) and Succeeding Offenses – The offender shall be fined in the amount of One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00).

If committed by a business establishment or juridical person, the owner, president, general manager or such other officer in charge thereof, shall be held liable. Moreover, such business establishment may be closed immediately and its business permit and license may be suspended or cancelled after due notice and hearing.

If the offender is a public officer or employee, an administrative case may also be filed against him/her pursuant to the Local Government Code of 1991 or the Civil Service Laws, rules and regulations, as the case may be.

SECTION 6. CITATION TICKET - The apprehending officer shall issue a citation ticket to the offender for any violation of this ordinance to be prepared by the Municipal Treasurer's Office.


**SECTION 8. ENFORCEMENT –** Members of the PNP, Municipal Health Office, Barangay and SK Officials including members of Tanod and other municipal officials to be determined by the Municipal Mayor.

**SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE –** If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by a competent court, the remaining sections or provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


**SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE –** All ordinances, resolutions, rules or regulations which are inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY –** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately, and shall remain in full force and effect during the period of Covid-19 Pandemic.
